ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02

AN ORDINANCE HIRING JOHN NYE AS POSITION OF UTILITY CLERK, ESTABLISHING A PAY RATE FOR THE POSITION OF UTLITY CLERK, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Vanlue, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. REPEAL. That all ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to enter into an employment contract with John Nye, to work on a part-time basis, to provide essential services to the Village of Vanlue.

SECTION 3: That John Nye shall be paid Fifteen and 00/100 Dollars per hour, for all hours worked in the position of Utility Clerk.

SECTION 4: That John Nye shall report to the Village Administrator, Leo Hendricks.

SECTION 5: That John Nye shall not be eligible for insurance or other employee benefits as a part time employee.

SECTION 6: This matter concerning the financial needs of the Village, which Council did declare an emergency and declared this Ordinance effective immediately and further, the Council did waive the three-reading rule and elect to pass by vote of Council this Ordinance after one reading. Such an agreement will take effect immediately in order that said employee can be compensated and is available starting March 1, 2024.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
