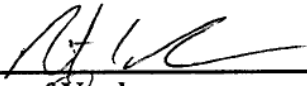
Temporary Appropriation Ordinance

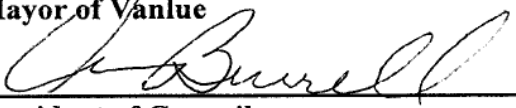

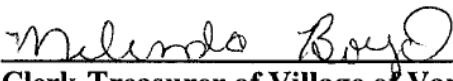
